



Welcome to University Medical Center Hamburg-Eppendorf (UKE)!

The University Medical Center Hamburg-Eppendorf (UKE) covers 80 interdisciplinary clinics, polyclinics and institutes in 14 centers. It is one of the largest among Hamburg's hospitals with 1,400 beds (plus 120 beds in the University Heart Center). Each year the medical center treats around 55,000 in-patients. Additionally, 250,000 out-patient treatments as well as 40,000 emergencies are treated here. Similar to most university hospitals, the University Medical Center Hamburg-Eppendorf offers a complete range of treatment options for patients. All common diseases are treated. New ideas in research and new approaches for the diagnosis and therapy of diseases are applied. For the Hamburg region, a large number of therapies and complicated surgical procedures, especially in the field of transplantation (heart, liver, kidney as well as bone marrow) can only be performed in the University Medical Center Hamburg-Eppendorf. In over 160 special consulting hours, patients are given advice and help – especially in chronic, rare and difficult-to-treat diseases.

The staff of the UKE numbers some 6,400 employees, including over 1,000 physicians and scientists. 2,900 nurses and therapists provide care in the in- and out-patient clinics. Another 1,000 employees conduct research in laboratories and investigative units and an additional 1,000 work in the administration or for technical services. The UKE also has approximately 500 trainees.

The New Clinic on the premises of the University Medical Center Hamburg-Eppendorf will provide highly efficient, state-of-the-art patient care. With over 700 beds, 16 operating rooms and a floor space of 42,000 square meters, the new building will be one of Europe's most modern and innovative medical facilities.
